What we are learning...

Topic:

We are celebrating Roald Dahl's birthday for the first two weeks in September. Acorns will be looking at George's Marvellous Medicine. All classes will be contributing to a school exhibition held on Friday 13th September. We will then be moving onto Nursery Rhymes as our topic looking at rhyming words, sequencing and vocabulary. The rhymes we will be focusing on are: Incy Wincy Spider, Humpty Dumpty, Twinkle Twinkle little star, Baa Baa Black Sheep

Phonics:

The first sounds we will be learning in phonics are: s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k, ck,e,u,r,h,b,f,ff,l,ll,le,ss
We will be practicing recognition of a words initial sounds and our segmenting and blending skills. This is where you break a word into its individual sounds before blending them together to read.

Maths:

We will be focusing on counting and number recognition this term. We will be working on our number ordering, touch counting and matching numeral to quantity. We are going to do this through our nursery rhymes and physical counting activities.
