What we are learning ...

Topic: This half term our topic is called 'Awesome Animals'. In Science we will look at identifying and naming a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will look at parts of these animals and then sort them to their correct habitat.

In Art we are looking at the French impressionist artist Henri Rousseau who is famous for 'Tiger in a tropical storm'. We are going to create their own interpretation of this piece of art.

In Computing we are going to explore the tools to paint program on purple mash to create their own imaginative animal.

Phonics:

We are going to quickly re-cap **phase 4 blends**, then move onto **phase5 alternative sounds**. For example, aitrain, ay-day, a.e- snake). Our spelling focus will be to learn som moree of the Yrl common exception words and to spell the **plural words** correctly, for example, adding s and es to the end of a word.

Maths:

We are recapping addition and subtraction by looking at fact families. For example 8 + 2 = 10, 10-2 = 8, 10-8= 2.

Then we are moving onto 2D and 3D shapes. We will look at recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Then we will make patterns with these shapes. Please save your re-cycling bits for us to make models so that we can name the shapes.

We will then move onto place value to 20. We will name, order and make amounts and continue to solve problems using these numbers.



English:

We will look at the book 'The owl who was afraid of the Dark' and 'Ugly Five'.

We will also be researching about an animas and writing a fact file about it. We are continuing to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces within our sentences. We are also going to extend our sentences using conjunctions.
