What we are learning...

Topic: Once upon a time...

This term we will be exploring fairy tales and the books we are going to be looking at are: The three billy goats gruff, Rapunzel and Cinderella. This links with our science topic of materials. If you have these books at home, you can read and discuss these with your child.

Phonics and English: Reception- This term we will be segmenting and blending words as well as writing our own sentences. Year 1 will be writing their own stories and exploring adjectives and question marks as well as making sure they use capital letters and full stops. Please read at home with your child to embed their phonics knowledge.

Maths:

This term in Birch class we are going to be exploring addition and subtraction to 20 and place value to 50 as well as exploring the 2 and 5 timetables. Practising counting at home will help with their skills in class.
