What we are learning...

Topic: Our topic this term is 'Journeys and Discoveries.' We will be learning about Ancient Egypt, which will include investigating Howard Carter's discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb and the importance of the Pharaohs. We will also be finding out about the daily lives of everyday Egyptians and the importance of the River Nile.

English: To start the term, we will be creating our own new species of animal, linked to our science learning, and writing an information text all about this new creature! Then, we will be putting ourselves in the shoes of the explorer Howard Carter, writing a first hand recount of his incredible discovery. Finally, we will be writing a story about the experiences of a refugee based on our class book, 'Shadow' by Michael Morpurgo.

Maths: We have lots of new maths learning to do this term, starting with decimals and percentages. This will involve us finding out how to convert between decimals, percentages and fractions. We will then move on to an algebra topic which is always a favourite in year 6, as it turns out to be much more fun than first imagined!
