What we are learning...

Topic:

Our topic this term is mini beasts. We will be using the books 'What the Ladybird Heard', 'Superworm' and 'The Hungry Caterpillar' to inspire our learning. During this topic we will be looking at the different habitats of the animals, their different features and life cycles. We will also have our own 'mini beast café' where the children can create their own mini beast inspired menus and role-play being a chef or waiter. If you have any books about creepy crawlies and bugs please bring them in to share.

Phonics:

Our sounding out and blending is helping us begin writing our own sentences. This term we are focusing on building our independence with our writing. We have learnt all sounds in Phase 2 and Phase 3 and this half term we will be focusing on reading and writing longer words covered in Phase 4 and 5. We will also continue practicing our sight words, this terms new words are: were, one, there, little, when, out, what and are. Matha:

This term in maths we will be looking at addition, subtraction, 3D shapes and time. There are lots of things you can do at home to help consolidate learning such as play board games which involve addition and subtraction, discuss the shapes you see in your surrounding environment and use language describing the different times of day.
