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What we are learning...

Topic: Our topic continues to be 'Journeys and Discoveries.' We are coming to the end of our learning about Ancient Egypt and will be moving onto a road trip of North America, investigating the different human and physical features we will encounter on our way. In art, we will be looking at the work of artist Paul Klee, created on his journeys across different continents.

English: We have finished our class book, 'Wonder' and are very excited to start a newly-published story 'Where the World Turns Wild', which will feed into lots of our English learning this term. It is a story full of adventure and drama! We will also be using our science learning, on healthy minds and bodies, to write an information text explaining how we can keep ourselves healthy.

Maths: We start this half term finishing our algebra topic, before moving onto a 'Measurement' topic. This learning will involve finding out about converting between different units of measurement, and investigating perimeter, area and volume.

We cannot quite believe we are halfway through the year already! It has been a great first week back, full of many 'proud' moments. The class have hit their learning with enthusiasm and maturity.
