As a school this term we are focussing on the values of

Topic: Wonderful Church Fenton!
In science, we will be finding out all about plants. We will be planting different seeds and bulbs and observing how they grow. We will also be looking at plants that grow fruit, tasting fruit and making fruit flowers as part of D&T.

We will also be taking a trip out round Church Fenton to see how the local area has changed.

Maths:

This half term in maths we will be focussing on place value within 50. In YI this includes finding one more & one less and comparing and ordering numbers within 50. We are continuing to practise counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 5's & 10's. Later in this half term we will be doing lots of practical maths based around measurement - length/height & weight.

Phonics and English:

In phonics, we will still be recapping phase 5 alternative sounds in preparation for Phonics Screening in June. We will also continue to learn more sight words.

In English, the children will be learning how to write instructions. We will also use the book 'Jasper's Beanstalk' to practise writing the days of the week. We will also be writing a recount of our walk around Church Fenton.
