Children can email me through 2email on Purple Mash if they would like to practice specific tables.</li><li>• There are some great maths challenges to improve your reasoning and problem solving. <a href="#">Mathematical Challenges</a></li><li>• Complete the 2do activity on Purple Mash - equivalent fractions.</li><li>• There is also a fun fraction wall game that you can play on Purple Mash.</li><li>• Access daily lessons on fractions at <a href="#">White Rose maths</a></li><li>• Revise mental addition and subtraction using <a href="#">supermovers</a></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share books daily and practise your home reader.</li><li>• Choose a book from <a href="#">Oxford Owls</a> to read. Try to choose something that you wouldn't normally pick.</li><li>• Write a review of your book on the Purple Mash 2do.</li><li>• Watch or read adverts. This is the perfect opportunity to send a handwritten letter to a family member or friend. If you have a touchscreen device, you could use 2Handwrite on Purple Mash - exploring different writing implements.</li><li>• Your grammar activity this week is the formation of nouns using a range of prefixes. This is a cloze activity set as a 2do (Superhero Shopping Trip) on Purple Mash.</li><li>• Use the advert writing template set as a 2do on Purple Mash to convince me to buy your toy. Remember to include lots of persuasive language.</li><li>• Remind yourself about facts and opinions by doing the following <a href="#">supermovers</a>.</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practice the balances that we have been learning this term. You will need a family member to help you with this. You will need to give clear instructions on what to do and be careful!</li> <li>• Continue to practice sending and receiving balls of different sizes using your hands and your feet. Rebound balls off walls or another willing participant! Develop your control taking care to adjust the direction and strength of your sending.</li> <li>• Join in with <a href="#">Joe Wicks</a> every morning at 9am for a thirty minute P.E. lesson. There are also shorter workouts available on his webpage.</li> <li>• Practice your times tables using <a href="#">supermovers</a>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On Tuesdays and Thursdays children can create some great pictures with the help of <a href="#">Rob Biddulph</a>, a children's author. The two from last week are already on.</li> <li>• Think about how you can use different textures to create patterns. This can be explored using Textures set as a 2do on Purple Mash or using items from around your home (remember to ask for permission first).</li> </ul>

<p>Learning Project</p> <p>Various activities covering the wider curriculum to be completed over the week.</p>
<p>● Let's Wonder: Try to place the shadows in the correct order on the Shadow Placing Purple Mash 2do.</p> <p>● Let's Create: Using 2Code on Purple Mash, use variables, timers and if statements to loop between night and day scenes. The program will talk you through any debugging that needs to be carried out.</p> <p>● Be Active: Explore light, reflection and shadows using the following <a href="#">supermovers</a>. Create a shadow dance either outside in the sun or inside using a light source (e.g. lamp or torch).</p> <p>● Time to Talk: Make a shadow theatre using puppets, cut outs or your hands and a lamp or torch. Explore what happens when the light source is moved. Use the shadows to act out a story that you tell. Ask for feedback.</p> <p>● Understanding Others and Appreciating Differences: Describe the personality and appearance of one of your friends. How are they different to you? (This can be done on Purple Mash).</p> <p>● Reflect: Think about how you described your friend. What makes your friendship so special?</p> <p>Some phonics and handwriting activities have been set as 2dos on Purple Mash for those children who still need to practice these.</p> <p>The 2do activities on Purple Mash will become accessible to children on different days - similar to how the learning would take place in school.</p> <p>The Radio Times have also put a list together of daily online 'lessons' at <a href="#">Kids online school timetable</a></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>-- Remember to check the 'Cherry Home Learning Suggestions' for plenty of other ideas to keep you busy! --</b></p>
