- Time to Talk: Are there ways in which you and your family can transform our world into a more beautiful and healthy place? What actions could you take? What actions do you already take?
- Understanding Others and Appreciating Differences: Read about Onesmus and the journey he has to collect water each day on the children's activity sheet. There are also some fun games that you can carry out by downloading the sheet from Christian Aid
- Reflect: On the above link, you can also download a Letters for Creation resource pack. This includes a collective worship and activities exploring this year's theme of Climate Justice.
