● Be Active: Go on a local walk. Collect objects that you could use to make your mosaic.

Let's Wonder: Visit Kids Rule! On the English Heritage website to chart the history of England from prehistoric England to the world wars. Research about Roman England.

- Let's Create: Create your own Roman mosaic on the Friday 2do or make your own using small pieces of coloured paper. There is also a video showing different methods on Kids Rule! - make a Roman mosaic
- Time to Talk: Follow the link and read about the Roman Conquest Talk to your family about all the positive things that came from the Roman conquest e.g. straight roads. Does this make the invasion okay?
- Understanding Others and Appreciating Differences: What is Ramadan? In the UK, this Islam festival has just ended. Learn a little bit about why Muslims fast during this time and how it is similar to the Christian festival of Lent.
- Reflect: You are too young to fast. However, almost all Muslims try to give up bad habits during Ramadan. It is a time for prayer and good deeds. They will try to spend time with family and friends and help people in need. What bad habit would you give up? Have you ever helped people in need?

The 2do activities on Purple Mash will become accessible to children on different days similar to how the learning would take place in school. Some phonics and handwriting activities have been set as 2dos on Purple Mash for those children who still need to practice these.
