Learning Project

(Various activities covering the wider curriculum to be completed over the week)

- **Let's Wonder:** Let's investigate sound by making a 'Pin Strummer'. You will need hair pins, sticky tape and clean, empty containers. You need to pull the ends of the pins apart slightly and open each one to a different angle. Then tape the straight arms of the pin to the container, in a row. Next, press down gently on the wiggly arms and let them pop back up. Does the angle change the noise? What happens if you press harder? Which materials make the best sound? I will put more information on Google classrooms for you. You could also share your results with me through Google classroom.
- **Let's Create:** Can you illustrate the Greek myth that you chose to write about? You could paint, draw or use Purple Mash.
- **Be Active:** Captain Tom did 100 laps of his garden, could you do 100 laps of yours?
- **Time to Talk:** Find someone this week to say 'Thank you' to. It could be the person who delivers the post or takes the bin or someone in your family. Think about how you could send the message, you could make a poster or put a sign in your window.
- **Understanding Others and Appreciating Differences:** Read the parable of the lost coin. How does this relate to our Christian Value of 'Forgiveness'?
- **Reflect:** Think about how you can demonstrate the Christian Value of Forgiveness this week.
