

HOME LEARNING: BIRCH CLASS Week9: When I Grow Up



Maths Tasks

 Daily numbots - Some of you have earned over 9000 coins!! Keep going:)

This week we are focusing on fractions. This is new learning in maths for us, so try your best. For now just think about finding a half (½) or a quarter (¼) of an object or shape. You need to learn that 2 equal parts or 4 equal parts makes a whole.

- What are fractions? Watch this <u>video</u> to find out more.
- We love super movers in Birch. Listen to Fractions with Joe Tracini.
- Can you find some 2D shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle) to draw round?
 You could draw round the side of a cereal box, a plastic cup, or a tin of soup. Fold the shape into halves or quarters. Then colour a half (½) or a quarter (¼) of the shape.
- Can you have a go at making your own smoothie? As a grown up for help. Can you half a banana? How about a strawberry or grape? Can you cut a piece of fruit into 2 and 4 equal pieces?





- There are daily maths lessons on <u>BBC Bitesize</u>, exploring different areas of maths. Have a go and try you best!
- Have a go at making your own fractions poster like this one.



By the end of Year 1 you need to be confident counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 5's and 10's - Can you skip while counting in 2's, 5's and 10's?

Reading Tasks

- Read to a grown up everyday There are some fantastic themed reading books available on Oxford Owl's E-Library. How many books can you read this week?
- Listen to 'When I Grow Up'. Discuss with a grown up what you want to be when you grow up. Has this story given you any ideas?



• Listen to <u>'Supertato'.</u> What kind of superhero is he? What kind of superhero would you be?



 Pick your favourite book you have at home and read it to a grown up or a sibling. Why is it your favourite book?

Reception, this week we are focusing on different ways of making 6. Continue to recap counting and recognising numbers to 20. You can hide numbers around your house and create a number once you have found them. You can also recap your subtraction skills. Can you use objects you have around your house to subtract and write number sentences for each calculation you do? Please have a look on Acorns home learning page for some maths activities!

Daily Phonics/Spelling Tasks

- Use the online phonics lessons to recap your phonics knowledge. Can you write a sentence using the words given? Can you think of another word with the same sound? Video uploaded everyday at 10am.
- Have a look at the Phonics PowerPoints on the school's website. Can you think of words that have those sounds in? Can you sound button those words and put them into a sentence?
- Have a go at this phonics lesson on <u>BBC</u> <u>Bitesize</u>. There is lots to explore and recap!
- Year 1 Can you think about all the different ai sounds that we have learnt? (ai, a, ay, a-e, ey, eigh, ae) Can you think of words that contain these ai sounds and put them in a sentence?

Starting from this week you will have a list of 6 words to practise each week. Remember to ask an adult to test you on them at the end of the week. This week's spellings are:

These are words that we use a lot in our reading and writing. Remember to write each word in a sentence to make sure that you understand its meaning.

Writing Tasks


- Can you write and tell me what you want to be when you grow up and why? Do you want to be a teacher, a vet, a doctor, a firefighter - the possibilities are endless!
- Have a little think to yourself, if you were a superhero what superpowers would you have? Use your knowledge of adjectives to describe what you would do if you were a superhero. 'When I was a little girl I always wanted to be a PowerPuff Girl because they helped save the world!' - Miss Hendrickson



- Year 1 Don't forget your capital letters, full stops and <u>adjectives</u> in your writing. Use your spelling mat to help you spell tricky words correctly.
- Reception Don't forget capital letters at the beginning of your sentences and full stops at the end. Use your spelling mat to help you spell tricky words.
- This is the <u>handwriting</u> scheme we follow at school. Try to do some handwriting practice weekly. Practise writing the letters of the alphabet - we start all our letters from the line.

Learning Project (Various activities covering the wider curriculum to be completed over the week)

Science/DT:

- Can you create a fact file about all the different types of animals. Can you include whether they are: carnivores, herbivores and omnivores?
- There are lots of fact file templates that can be found online.

Art/Music:

- Can you create a comic strip for a superhero of your choice or one you have created yourself?
- Can you create and draw/ paint your own superhero? Try and use a different technique, maybe try and blow the paint through a straw and see what happens?





Geography/Understanding the World:

- Can you do some research about England? How many people live here? What is the capital city? Can you name the places you have visited in England?
- Where does your favourite superhero live?
- If you could live anywhere in the world, where would it be?

RE/PSHE:

- Watch this video about <u>long- distance friendships</u>. I know that you are all missing your friends. Why don't you try writing a letter to a friend telling them how much you miss them and what sort of things you have been getting up to at home.

Computing:

- Y1 Explore Purple Mash and see what you can create. You can also upload photos and your work onto your file which I can see.
- Reception Explore <u>Numberjacks</u> on Youtube. There are lots of different areas of maths covered and they are great fun to watch!

Eco:

- It is World Ocean Day on Monday 8th June. Can you think of different ways we can protect our oceans?
- There are lots of different resources available on Twinkl relating to World Ocean Day, including this activity pack!
- Can you learn and name all the oceans?
