- 2. **Beat the Timer:** Set a timer and see if you can read all the words before the timer runs out.
- 3. Lucky Dip: Fold up the words and take them out of a box one at a time. Open them up to see what words you have found.
- 4. Copy Me Do: Read and copy the words. You could write them with water outside on the floor, in chalks, in sand and shaving foam.
- 5. Tricky Word Bingo: Photocopy the sheets or write out the words and use them to play bingo.
