




### Reading Tasks

Our book this week is:

*We're Going on a Bear Hunt.*

### Daily Phonics Tasks

Every day we will be looking at a new sound in class. Can you find objects around your house beginning with this sound? Can you sort objects by their initial sound?



A good way of introducing the sounds is by watching Jolly Phonics videos on YouTube, e.g. *Jolly Phonics m*. This teaches children the sound through a fun song and actions. This week the letters we will be looking at are:

Monday: Letter i

Tuesday: Letter n

Wednesday: Letter m

Thursday: Letter d

Friday: Can children sort objects beginning with i, n, m and d (i.e. putting objects next to the letters they begin with)?

Remember to use your letter sounds flashcards (you can find them on the school website, go to: *Classes, Mercury*).

This week we are looking at the number 2. You can find out all about number two with Numberblocks on YouTube:


