## What we are learning...

**Topic:** For our whole school topic 'The Great, The Bold and The Brave' Jupiter class will learn about 'The Romans'. The children will train to be a soldier in the Roman Army before designing and making their own Roman shield using representations inspired by Roman Gods and Goddesses. In science we will explore different forces, starting by investigating friction.

**English:** We are starting year 3 by reading 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers. Through this book will be able to explore and celebrate our planet as well as reflect on the last year. We will then create instructions for how to play the Roman game 'Rota'. To finish the half term the children will write a character description for the BFG.

**Maths:** In Maths we will begin by applying our knowledge of numbers to counting up to a thousand. The more practise you can fit in at home the better!

Remember to also keep going with your times tables, perhaps start by recapping 2s, 5s and 10s.
