
VIDEO NEEDED - Add and Subtract 10s

Use the phonics powerpoint on the Earth class page to recap all the sounds from phase 3 & phase 5. Don't forget to sing the rainbow first.


Use Tuesday's slides to read and write words containing alternative spellings for the 'ai' sound just like we do in class.

### Handwriting


- Can you practise writing your name? Write your first name, middle name and surname. Remember to use tall capital letters at the beginning of each name.

This week in RSHE we are thinking about what makes us special.




Watch the Theseus clip:
