After a successful trial with some of our older children this week, we will begin offering Google Meet sessions for our younger children starting next week. As highlighted in the parent questionnaire, we know this is something parents would welcome. We feel that these sessions will help children both at home and school feel more connected and support their wellbeing.

In EYFS and KS1 we will hold a minimum of one session next week and will increase the number of opportunities thereafter.

In order to follow the STAR MAT policy, all online meetings will be conducted through Google Meet. Please take a look at the information below to guide you on how to access these sessions.

- Your child's class teacher will be in touch at least one day before to let you know the time of the Google Meet.
- Log in to Google Classroom using your child's school email address (@kf.starmat.uk).
- Approximately 10 minutes prior to the session a link will be posted on the class stream.
- At the planned session time, click on the link and follow the instructions.
- At the end of the session, please ensure you 'hang up' by clicking on the red telephone icon.

Please note that an a link to join the session will only be shared on the class stream with children who have returned their online Acceptable Usage Agreement form.

If your child does not yet have a school email address, these are currently being set up and the login and password details will be shared with you at the beginning of next week.
