Daily Phonics/Spelling Tasks

Reception - Today I would like you to learn the new digraph ar. A digraph is when two letters make one sound. Can you say it to a grown up? Can you have a go at writing it in our special writing? Can you practice drawing the sound button underneath?

Year 1 - This week we are looking at the 'igh" family for alternative spellings. This can be tricky so just try your best! We will be going over this on your return to school so don't worry!

Use the Phonics PP on Venus Class page on the school's website. Just like we do at school, sing the alphabet with a grown up or sibling.

What sentences can you create with the alternative igh spellings? Don't forget to use your sound buttons to help you. When you are looking at the different igh graphemes - think about where you can hear the igh in a word? is it as the front, middle or end?

Our book for the first part of this term is The Bog Baby by Jeanne Willis. This will be the focus of our writing.



You might have this book at home. If you don't, you can find a read along version on youtube.

Reception and Year 1 - Today I would like you to create a missing poster for our bog baby. I have come into school and he has gone missing! Where could he be?

Use the description of the bog baby in the story to draw the bog baby. Add your description of what he looks like, feels like and how much you want to find him.

Learning Project

DT - In Design Technology this term we are learning to sew. I know some of you at home have created some amazing bog babies.

Today I would like you to practice a running stitch. Watch this <u>video</u> to help you. Ask a grown up to help you thread the needle as this can be tricky!



If you don't have any thread or needles at home - Can you practice weaving? Watch this <u>video</u> to help you. All you'll need is some paper cut into strips. Can you make a bog baby using this technique?
