Today I would like you to practice your subtraction skills by not crossing 10.

Say the number sentence to yourself. $15-4 =$

Fifteen takeaway 4 equals. That might help you remember what number you are taking away.


Extra Maths (This is optional)

- In Year 1 you need to practise 'retrieving' (find or extract) information from a piece of text. Can you have a go at answering these questions once you have listened to Owl Babies? Remember you can always go back and listen again to find the answer.
 - What were the owl babies called?
 - Where did they live?
 - What happened when the owl babies woke up?
 - What did Bill want?

Challenge:

- Why did the owl babies have to be brave?

Daily Phonics/Spelling Tasks

Writing Tasks

Reception - Today I would like you to learn the new trigraph ear. A trigraph is when three letters make one sound. Can you say it to a grown up? Can you have a go at writing it in our special writing? Can you practice drawing the sound button underneath?

Watch [Geraldine the Giraffe](#) and encourage your child to repeat the sound. Encourage your child to repeat the sound and action.

What ear objects can you find in your house?

Can you read words:hear, dear, near, gear, tear, year

Can you have a go at writing your own sentence using one of the words above?

I can hear an owl hoot at night.

Year 1 - This week we are looking at the 'oa" family for alternative spellings. This can be tricky so just try your best! We will be going over this on your return to school so don't worry!

Today I would like you to recap the oa sounds you know so far and to learn the new grapheme 'o'.

Use the Phonics PP on Venus Class page on the school's website. Just like we do at school, sing the alphabet with a grown up or sibling.

Today I would like you to be a word sorter. Use the sheet on our class page. Can you write two sentences using the words from the sheet?

Reception and Year 1 - Today I would like you to explore Chinese New Year.

Year 1 - After you have watched the video, can you write some sentences using your own words telling me how Chinese people prepare to celebrate the New Year?

Don't forget your capital letters and full stops. Challenge - can you use the conjunction and or because to extend your writing?

Reception - Can you list three things the children in the video did to help their Mum prepare for the New Year celebrations?
