This half term we will be playing a range of listening games as well as looking at the initial sounds of words.

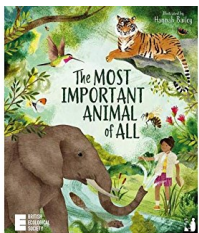
We will practise writing our names, making sure we form our letters correctly.
