What we are learning...

Topic:

We will begin our term for the first two weeks learning all about bees. We will also be making our own bee art. Later in the half term we will be reading some fairy tales! In science we will be learning about different animals. In Design and Technology we will be making our own Colour Monster puppets.

Phonics:

This half term we will be revisiting Phase 3 sounds, e.g. sh, ch, th, air, ear... We will be reading and writing sentences containing these sounds.

English:

This half term we will be writing facts about bees. Retelling the story of Hansel and Gretel and writing a description of a character from Rapunzel.

Spellings:

Maths:

In maths this half term we will be looking at place value of numbers to 10.

We will be counting, practising writing numbers in words (one, two, three, etc), looking at greater/smaller numbers and introducing the $<$, $>$ and $=$ symbols. We will also be looking at ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd 3rd, etc).

Here is the Beehive, Five Little Bees Count to Ten, Heads, Shoulders, Knees and Toes, The Animal Farm, If You're Happy and You Know It, The Grand Old Duke of York and Five Little Ducks.
