What we are learning...

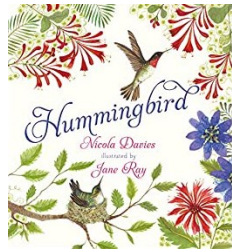
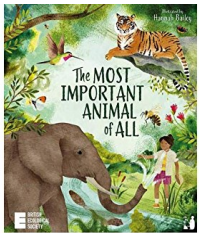
Topic:

For the first two weeks of this half term we will be learning all about Hummingbirds. We will also be doing lots of Hummingbird art using different types of media. Later in the half term we will be reading some fairy tales! In science we will be learning about different animals and in DT we will be making our own Colour Monster puppets.

Phonics:

This half term we will be revisiting Phase 3 sounds, e.g. sh, ch, th, air, ear... We will be reading and writing sentences containing these sounds.

Focus poems, rhymes and songs

Each week we will have a focus poem, rhyme or song to learn— sometimes with sign language, actions or body percussion. Each week we will let you know the name of our poem, rhyme or song so that you can practise at home.

English:

This half term we will be writing facts about Hummingbirds. Retelling the story of Hansel and Gretel and writing a description of a character from Rppunzel.

Spellings:

This half term your child will be given weekly spellings to practise at home. More information to follow.

Maths:

In maths this half term we will be looking at place value of numbers to 10.

We will be counting, practising writing numbers in words (one, two, three, etc), looking at greater/smaller numbers and introducing the <, > and = symbols. We will also be looking at ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd 3rd, etc).
