What we are learning...

Topic: Our topic this term is South America. In this topic we will be looking at the human and physical geography of the continent and comparing areas of it to areas within the United Kingdom. We will also be looking at the problems that the Amazon rainforest faces.

English: In English this term we will be looking at a range of text types linked to our topic of South America. This will include, a sonnet linked to jaguars, , a recount based on a survival story, and a persuasive speech about deforestation.

Maths: This term we will be focusing on place value, which includes numbers to 10,000, rounding numbers and roman numerals. We will then be moving onto addition and subtraction. A big aim for this term will be developing the children problem solving skills. Strategies to help with this will be integrated into each lesson.

Science: In science, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. This will involve studying how plants reproduce, and looking at the life cycles of different animals.
