



At Kirk Fenton CE Primary School we use an online system called Tapestry to record and store observations and assessments relating to each child in EYFS. This is a safe and secure system and one that enables parents and carers to access their child's learning journey at any time. They can share it with their child, family and friends at home and also post any comments and photographs of their own, helping to create a holistic view of the child and strengthen the parent partnership. It will also show children's developmental progress through the Early Learning Goals.

You should receive a letter explaining our use of Tapestry in your new starter packs with a form to complete. Please complete this as soon as possible and return to school in order to get your Tapestry account set up.

Once you have created your account, keep an eye out for the observations which are added from school. We also encourage you to submit any observations from home. As a school, we really value parental input and feel that strong communication between home and school makes a big difference in supporting your child to realise their full potential.
