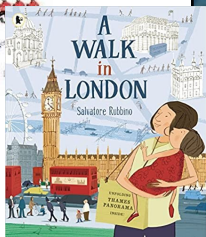

Phonics:

This half term we will be practising sounds such as h, b, c, f, ff, l, ll and ss.

We will also use our knowledge of sounds to record consonant, vowel, consonant words.

Maths:

This term we will be focusing on gaining confidence with numbers 1 to 5, representing them, comparing them and looking at the composition of these numbers. We will also be identifying one more and one less using these numbers. We will learn about shapes and discuss their properties, as well as using positional language such as under, behind, in front, and on top.
