

## Jaguars - Year 5 Spellings - Autumn Term 2



We are doing spellings a little differently this year. There are three groups of spellings to learn before half term (a list of words per fortnight, with an extra week at the end for recapping all spelling). The spelling focus words link to a spelling focus we have been looking at in class, and the other 5 words are from the year statutory 5/6 or year 3/4 spelling list. I will remind you each fortnight to learn the next group of spellings. **You will be tested on 10 random words which fall under the spelling focus section and 10 from the year 5/6 statutory spelling list on one of the last days of this half term (16th December).** This will help us know if the spellings have stuck when you have learned them!

I have included a selection of example words, however the rule does include a larger range of words that the children will learn at school. Please let me know if you have any questions.
