<p>Rule:</p> <p>Adding the suffix -ly</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a root word ends in e then it must be dropped before the suffix is added. • If a root word ends in y then it needs to be dropped and change to i before the suffix is added. 	<p>Rule:</p> <p>Adding the suffix -tion and -sion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The suffix -tion and -sion sound the same. • If the word is related to one that ends in d or se then the suffix is -sion. • If the noun is related to a word ending in 'ate' then it is -tion. 	<p>Rule:</p> <p>Apostrophes for contractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apostrophes are used where two words have been joined and some letters are missed out so that a contraction is formed.
