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Dear parents/carers,

On Wednesday 9th February, I will be starting a SATS booster club to help the class be fully prepared for their SATS assessments which take place in May. SATs are standardised assessment tests administered by primary schools in England, to children in Year 2 and Year 6 to check their educational progress.

The SATS in year 6 consist of the following assessments:

KS2 reading SATs: One paper with questions that are based on 3 passages of text. Students get 1 hour to answer the questions on the paper.

KS2 English grammar, punctuation and spelling SATs: The written element of the spelling, punctuation and grammar SATs consists of a grammar and punctuation paper which lasts for 45 minutes.

There is also a 20-word aural spelling test which lasts around 15 minutes.

KS2 maths SATs: Paper 1 is the arithmetic paper which will last for 30 minutes. It will contain fixed response questions where children have to give the correct answers to calculations. Papers 2 and 3 will involve a wider range of question types including multiple choice, true or false and reasoning based. Both papers will last 40 minutes each.

The club will start straight after school and will finish at 4.15pm. During the booster club the class is split into small groups who each work with an adult. This ensures the groups can really focus on the learning they need to consolidate. The club starts with squash and a biscuit which has been a big pull in previous years!
