


Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

Supporting Your Child



- Help them to be independent zipping coats, putting on shoes, tidying toys
- Using a knife and fork to eat independently
- Help them be independent when going to the toilet
- Respect toys and equipment
- Help your child to make choices for themselves
- Talk and listen, encouraging talk
- Praise their efforts the process, not necessarily the product
- Give them time to play imaginatively, developing concentration
- Play games which involve taking turns and sharing
- Provide a wide range of active experiences
- Read stories together
- Have fun together!
