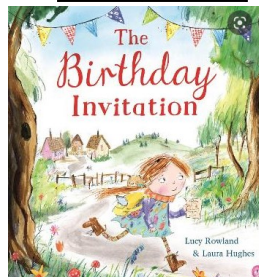
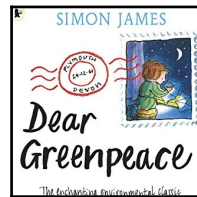
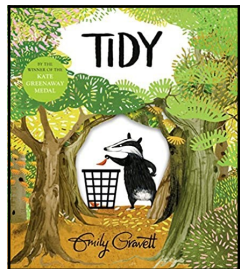
What we are learning...
