What we are learning...

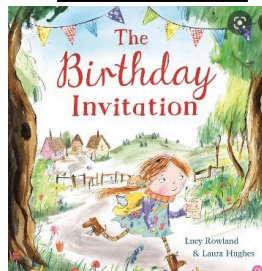
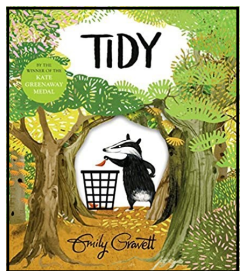
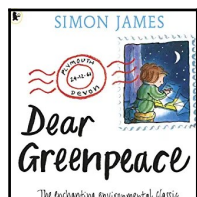
Topic:
