

ROSEN CLASS NEWS



Topic: We have started our learning with 2 weeks of focusing on poetry and the work of Michael Rosen. Our topic will then be 'hospitals and healthcare', celebrating heroes such as Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale. In science we will learn about animals including humans. All Tigers Class children will learn how to use Google Classroom

Maths: Our initial work on number will support children to become confident with understanding and using numbers to 100 and just beyond. Children will learn how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s to prepare them for their times tables. Weekly practise on Numbots, TT Rockstars as well as identifying coins will help your child in class. English: Our writing focus will be: acrostic and shape poetry about tigers; a humorous story linked to 'George's Marvellous Medicine' and a diary in role as Mary Seacole. Home reading books will resume next week and book bags should be brought in each day. Library books can be kept at home and a message will be sent home to let you know when they need to be returned. These books are intended to be shared as they may be beyond your child's reading ability.
