## What we are learning...

Topic: in several areas of the curriculum this half term we will be focusing on the polar regions and how they are changing, particularly in geography and science.

Maths: This half term, we will begin by focusing on addition and subtraction. After we have practised and perfected exchanging, we will move onto focusing on money - counting, comparing and finding the difference between amounts. Towards the end of the half term, we will be focusing on multiplication - making equal groups and arrays.

English: For the first few weeks of the half term, we will be focusing on writing setting descriptions for a chosen habitat (linking to our geography and science topics). After this, we will be writing a persuasive letter to the head teacher to reduce the use of plastics in school.

Science: This half term, our science topic is "Living things and their habitats" with a focus on the polar regions. The key scientist we will be focusing on is Ernest Shackleton
