What we are learning...

Topic: Our history topic will focus on World War 1. This is a very interesting topic, where we will explore the impact on technology, women's rights, the world, and how Church Fenton was impacted.

English: In English, we will be writing a historical narrative, linked to our topic. We will also be looking at non-chronological reports. Our grammar focus will be to try and add parenthesis and relative clauses to our writing.

Maths: We will be looking at multiplication and division, in particular: factors, square numbers and prime numbers. We will then be moving onto fractions.

Science: In Science, we are investigating materials: their properties and how they react and change. This will involve a lot of practicals which the children will be able to experiment and investigate.
