

What we are learning...

Our topic this half term will explore India and what it is like to live there. We will learn all about Chembakoli, a small village in the South of India. In science we will be looking at how animals in India are adapted to their environment. In RE we will learn about the importance of Easter.

Maths: We will be working on Multiplication and Division, as well as Length, Height and Mass, and Capacity and Temperature. Regular Numbots practice makes a huge difference to mental maths skills. Try to complete 10 minutes 3-4 times per week.

English: In English we will be writing a non-chronological report about an Indian Animal and a traditional tale set in India. New spelling lists are on Edshed, please make sure your child is regularly practising these. Spellings will also be sent every Monday so your child can practise their handwriting. Our class novels will be 'The Climbers' and 'Harry the Poisonous Centipede.'
