<u>What we are learning...</u>

Our topic this half term will explore why 1666 was an important year in London.. We will learn all about the Great Fire of London and how it has had an impact on fire safety today. In science we will be looking at what plants need in order to grow and will be conducting an experiment to see which is the best condition for a plant to thrive. In RE we will learn about special and scared times.

Maths: We will be working on Mass, Capacity and Temperature as well as Fractions and Time. Regular Numbots and TTRockstars practice makes a huge difference to mental maths skills. Try to complete 10 minutes 3-4 times per week.

English: In English we will be writing an explanation about how seeds grow and a diary entry for Samuel Pepys. New spelling lists are on Edshed weekly, please make sure your child is regularly practising these. Spellings will also be sent every Monday so your child can practise their handwriting.
