<u>Sun Cream</u>: As we head into summer, please ensure that you child has sun cream applied every morning and a sun hat provided.


School Dinners: All dinners must now be ordered in advance.

What we are learning

This half term our topic is 'What is your superpower?' We are now heading towards the end of the year and with it, we are now preparing to be ready for Year !! We will be learning about our bodies, how to be healthy and what we are capable of.

Reading Books

As we come towards the end of Reception, it is <u>essential</u> that the children continue to read <u>at least 3 times</u> <u>per week</u> at home.

You may now notice your child building up fluency and turning into a real reader!

Phonics

We have learnt all of our Phase 3 sounds:

We are now in Phase 4 which focuses on longer and more complex words with the sounds we already know.

E.g. scrunch, strain, splutter and bands with several consonants adjacent to each other.

Please continue to support your children with reading at home at least 3 times per week and ideally daily.

Maths



In Maths, we are developing our knowledge of number pattern. This half term we will be learning about doubles, sharing and odd/even numbers.

We are now deepening our knowledge in readiness for Year I.
