


What are we learning:

Our topic this term is: Is anyone out there? Where we will be discussing Space!

In English, we will be continuing to work towards year 5 targets through a range of text types. Our first of the term will be a persuasive piece, with a focus on modal verbs, persuasive language, and using a variety of sentence types. We will still be focusing on embedding our Shakespeare class targets for writing, which are: recognising when to use a comma or a full stop, separating clauses with commas, punctuating speech correctly, and using exciting vocabulary.

In maths, we will be continuing to look at angles and shape, and then will move onto adding and subtracting decimals, negative numbers and then looking at volume.



The focus on geography will be on reading OS maps. Will be learning how to read 6 figure coordinates and how to read a compass.

Our Christian Values




Our Chrsitian values this term are: Forgiveness and Respect
