#### What we are learning

This half term our topic is 'Me and My World'. In Geography we will be finding out about 'Our Local Area' and making maps of the school and Church Fenton. We are learning about 'Our Body and Senses' in Science. In art, we will be exploring self portraits through different artists using a range of media. In English, we will be thinking about climate change and making posters. We will also be writing our own autumn poem linked to the senses as well as writing character descriptions based othe main characters from Little Red Riding Hood. Our focus texts are:

#### Reading

Your child will be bringing their first Year I reading book home in the next couple of days. From next week your child will read 3 times a week with an adult during reading practice sessions. Please make sure that your child has their reading record and reading book in their bags every day.

You can support your child by reading regularly with them at home. Our recommendation is little and often, at least 3/4 times a week.

# Spellings

In Year I, spellings are part of the weekly homework. The children will access Spelling Shed to support their learning. Logins and further information will be sent out shortly.

# Phonics

We will continue to follow the Little Wandle phonics scheme. This half term we will be recapping phase 3 & phase 4 sounds. We will then begin to teach phase 5 sounds.

#### Tricky Words:

This half term we will be recapping all of the 49 tricky words from reception. Your child needs to be secure sight reading all of these words before moving on to Year I words. Further information about how you can help with spellings of tricky words will be sent out next week after we have completed a short assessment.

# Maths



In Maths we will be counting with objects to IO, comparing numbers, finding one more and one less and practising our number bonds. We will then move on to addition and subtraction within IO. We will also be focussing on forming all numbers up to IO correctly.

Accessing Numbots regularly will hugely improve your child's mental maths skills. Our recommendation is 20 minutes at least 3 times a week. This is part of your child's weekly homework. Login details will be sent out early next week so that you can help our child assess the programme.
