What we are learning

This half term our topic is 'Me and My World'. We will be investigating climate change and climate justice and creating a piece of artwork to represent our thoughts about this.

Our history topic is 'Explorers' and we will be learning about the areas of the world that different explorers have visited and looking at how exploration has changed over time.

In our English sessions, we will be looking at narrative writing and focussing on description. We will also be writing about different explorers and describing the places they visited.

Super Science

Our topic is 'Animals including humans'. Our Year I children will be learning about the senses. Year 2 children will be investigating life cycles.

Phonics and Spelling

Year I children will begin by reviewing phase 3 and 4 and will then begin learning new sounds from phase 5.

Year I children will be set a series of assignments on Spelling Shed which will last for the half term. These assignments will support their phonics and will be linked to spellings we have learnt in class.

Year 2 children will begin by reviewing phase 5. Year 2 children will be set an assignment on Spelling Shed each week which is linked to the spellings we will learn in class. Playing these fun games 3 or 4 times a week for between 5 and 10 minutes is ideal and will support their learning in class. The assignments will be set each Friday.

Maths



This half term our YI children will be learning to sort, count, order, compare and represent numbers to 10. They will then move on to addition and subtraction within 10.

Our Y2 children will learn to order, compare and represent numbers to 100. They will then move on to addition and subtraction using number bonds to 10 to help calculate number bonds to 100. They will also be counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.
