## **Phonics and Spelling**

Year I children will be learning phase 5 and will be set spellings on Spelling Shed to support their phonic knowledge. The assignments will be set each Friday.

# Maths



This half term our YI children will be learning to recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes. They will then begin extending their place value knowledge to numbers up to 20.

Our Y2 children will also be learning about shape and will be looking at sides and vertices on 2D shapes and exploring vertices, faces and edges on 3D shapes. We will also be learning about symmetry. We will then move on to working with money.
