Welcome to the Spring 1 newsletter. | hope you have all had a joyus and restful Christmas.



What are we learning:

In English, we will be focusing more on our punctuation, especially using apostrophes and commas correctly. We will also be continuing to develop our sentence level writing by taking our time to pick the most effective vocabulary and sentence structure to create the greatest impact. We will be writing a range of text types, starting with a persuasive letter.

In maths, we are continuing with multiplication and division. We will be using our previously learnt times table knowledge to solve calculations such as a 2 digit number multiplied by a 1 digit number (e.g. 25×7).

Then we will move onto calculating and understanding length and perimeter.
