# Spellings

At the moment, the focus is on tricky words but this may change from week to week. Again, regular practice will support your child's reading and writing.

This half term there will be team points and small prizes on offer for those children who access the most games on Spelling Shed each week.

### Phonics

We will continue to follow the Little Wandle phonics scheme. This half term we will be teaching the next phase of Phase 5 sounds.

We will update you regularly on our teaching of phonics and how you can support your child at home.

#### <u>Tricky Words:</u>

This half term your child will be sent home a list of all the Year I words they have been learning since Septem ber. It is important that your child is able sight read these words Please help your child practise them at home. If your child is able to read these words fluently please begin to practise spelling them correctly.

#### Maths



In Maths we will be looking at place value and addition and subtraction within 20., along with measurement.

Accessing Numbots regularly will hugely improve your child's mental maths skills. Our recommendation is 20 minutes at least 3 times a week. This is part of your child's weekly homework. This half term there will be team points and small prizes on offer for those children who access Numbots for the most minutes each week
