

Recognise quantities to 10 without counting (subitise)

Recognise numerals 0 - 10



Children should be able to recognise the numerals to 10 out of sequence.

### Things to try

- Look for where numbers are represented in amounts e.g.: on playing cards or on dice.
- Roll one dice (die) and say the amount.
- Roll a dice (die) and then grab a corresponding quantity of toys e.g.: toy dinosaurs.
- Notice small quantities as playing with toys - how many blue cars, etc.
- Hold fingers up and shout how many are held up.
- Look in places like fruit bowls and say how many. Then count to check.
- Look for numerals in the environment. For example, prices in a shop, house numbers
- Play on Numbots. The subitising games are fantastic!
