Year 1 - Spring 2

Know number bonds to 10

Recognise numbers to 50

The children need to be able to find all the different ways to make 10.

$$0 + 10 = 10 \quad 1 + 9 = 10 \quad 2 + 8 = 10 \quad 3 + 7 = 10 \quad 4 + 6 = 10$$

$$5 + 5 = 10 \quad 6 + 4 = 10 \quad 7 + 3 = 10 \quad 8 + 2 = 10 \quad 9 + 1 = 10 \quad 10 + 0 = 10$$

Things to try

- Play 'tennis'. If you say a number, e.g. 6, can you child reply with the number bond?
- Try to beat the timer. How long does it take to write all the bonds? Can you beat your previous time?
- Challenge - can you write the matching subtraction statements? e.g. $10 - 7 = 3$.
- Listen to songs like this one
