## What are we Learning:

Our topic this term is: What were Stone Age settlements like?

In English, we will be writing a narrative about a natural disaster, based on the events at Pompeii. After that, we will be moving onto a narrative based on a child finding themselves in the Neolithic Stone Age. We will continue with a focus on good handwriting and sentence structure, whilst also looking at conjunctions and tense.



In maths, our focus will be on Mass and Capacity followed by Fractions and then money. We will also be continuing with our weekly timestable quiz.



Our science topic will be looking at forces and magnets. The children will compare how things move on different surfaces, observe how magnets attract or repel each other and we will be able to describe magnets as having two poles

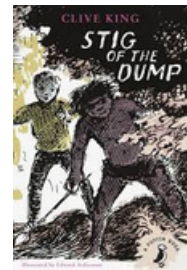
