Phonics

This half term, we will continue to learn new phase 5 alternative sounds and spellings. We will also be recapping all phases of phonics in preparation for phonics screening in June.

Phonics Books

Green phonics books have now been sent home. These contain a list of all the tricky words that the children need to be able to sight read by the end of Year I. Please practise at home with your child. If your child is confident reading these words, they could practise spelling them. We will add new sounds and tricky words each Friday, so please ensure your child has their book in their bag every day. In the weeks leading up to phonics screening W/C 10.6.24, we will also include a list of 20 real and 20 alien words (similar to those in the screening) for you to practise with your child.

Maths

This half term we will be continue to look at and place value within 50. We will also be learning about length & height, mass & volume and multiplication & division.
