What we are learning

This half term our topic is 'Marvellous Materials'. We will be experimenting with different materials and using these to create our own sculptures during our Art lessons.

Phonics and Spelling

In YI, we will be continuing with our Phase 5 practising to ensure we are ready for our phonics screening. Our reading books will match our phonic knowledge. Some children will be attending additional phonics practise sessions to ensure they build their fluency whilst some children will begin practising their comprehension skills in a more formal way.

Y2 children will be doing a mixture of revision of phase 5 phonics and spelling sessions.

The spelling assignments for both year groups will be changed on a Friday.

Reading books

Please ensure your child brings their book bag everyday as we practise our reading daily. Your child's book will be changed every Monday.

We will visit the library each Friday to choose our reading for pleasure book.

Maths





In Y2, we have started learning how to measure in centimetres and metres and compare different heights and lengths. We will then learn how to measure weight, capacity and temperature. Our final unit of learning this half term will be on fractions. We will learn to find quarters, halves and three quarters. Children will need to use both Numbots and TTR at home to support their learning in the classroom. Our KIRF is to automatically recall the 5 times table. In YI, we will be starting our multiplication and division unit by learning to make equal groups and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will then learn to find halves and quarters of quantities and shapes. Our YI KIRF is to be able to count in 2's, 5's and 10's and to know all odd and even numbers to 20.
