Know the multiplication and division facts for the 5 times table

$1 \times 5 = 5$			
	$5 \times 1 = 5$	$5 \div 1 = 5$	$5 \div 5 = 1$
$2 \times 5 = 10$	5 x 2 = 10	$10 \div 2 = 5$	$10 \div 5 = 2$
$3 \times 5 = 15$	5 x 3 = 15	15 ÷ 3 = 5	$15 \div 5 = 3$
$4 \times 5 = 20$	5 x 4 = 20	$20 \div 4 = 5$	$20 \div 5 = 4$
$5 \times 5 = 25$	5 x 5 = 25	$25 \div 5 = 5$	25 ÷ 5 = 5
$6 \times 5 = 30$	5 x 6 = 30	$30 \div 6 = 5$	30 ÷ = 6
$7 \times 5 = 35$	5 x 7 = 35	$35 \div 7 = 5$	$35 \div 5 = 7$
$8 \times 5 = 40$	5 x 8 = 40	$40 \div 8 = 5$	$40 \div 5 = 8$
$9 \times 5 = 45$	5 x 9 = 45	$45 \div 9 = 5$	$45 \div 5 = 9$
$10 \times 5 = 50$	5 x 10 = 50	50 ÷ 10 = 5	$50 \div 5 = 10$
11 x 5 = 55	5 x 11 = 55	55 ÷ 11 = 5	55 ÷ 5 =11
$12 \times 5 = 60$	5 x 12 = 60	$60 \div 12 = 5$	$60 \div 5 = 12$

Things to try

- Listen to songs and chants such as https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6lti2YOzplw You could even create your own song! If your child creates their own song, this can make the times tables even more memorable.
- Use what you already know If your child knows that $2 \times 5 = 10$, they can use this fact to work out that $6 \times 5 = 30$.
- Test the Parent Your child can make up their own tricky division questions for you e.g. What is 25 divided by 5?
 They need to be able to multiply to create these questions.
