What are we Learning:

Our topic this term is: Why do plants have flowers?

In English, we will be continuing to write a narrative based on a child finding themselves in the Neolithic Stone Age. After, we will writing an email to their new teacher telling them about themselves. We will continue with a focus on good handwriting and sentence structure.



In maths, we will be focusing on telling the time to the minute, being able to differentiate between AM and PM, as well as reading a 12 hour digital clock. We will then move onto shape and then finally finsih on statistics. We will also be continuing with our weekly timestable quiz.



Our science topic will be looking at plants. The children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and investigate how water is transported within plants.



In Geography, we will be looking at how rivers are formed, revisiting rivers across the United Kingdom, the physical features of a river. We will also be exploring the impact of flooding within local communities.



What are we Reading?

This term we will be reading 'Stitch Head' by Guy Bass.



We will also be reading a range of picture books and short texts linked to our science, history and writing topics.

- Complete the spelling assignment on EdShed:

- To read each day, with their school book.
